

## Dixon among female athletes honored

Burlington County College sophomore Dawn Dixon is among the athletes honored by the New Jersey Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women.

The New Jersey AIAW honors athletes from schools throughout the state. Dixon, a soccer standout, was recognized as the Woman of the Year representing BCC.

Dixon, a graduate of Rancocas Valley High School, helped BCC win two Garden State Athletic Conference championships and two NJCAA Region 19 titles. Dixon was a midfielder who helped the Barons compile a 25-3-2 record over the past two seasons.

As a sophomore, Dixon was selected Player of the Year in Region 19 (coaches select the all-region team, then rank the top five players and Dixon was No. 1). She also made All-GSAC and was honorable mention NJCAA Division 1 All-America. Dixon finished the fall semester with a 4.0 grade-point average and carries a 3.936 GPA through three semesters.

“We are extremely proud of Dawn and all her accomplishments. She is an outstanding athlete and student who always gave her best,” BCC athletic director Heather Conger said in a new release issued Wednesday by the college.
