SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: G & C Enterprises, Inc. Scholarship

DATE INITIALLY ESTABLISHED:

PURPOSE: The scholarship was established by G & C Enterprises, Inc., a local general construction contractor, to encourage students to pursue a career in construction management. The scholarship is designed to combine academic pursuit in a construction discipline while also combining a co-op summer working feature.

AMOUNT OF AWARD: Full-time tuition, fees, and books for one year (Fall and Spring semesters)

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Must be enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 15 credits) at Burlington County College in the Drafting and Design Technology Program and must successfully complete DDT 101, Architectural Drafting and Construction, as well as other courses required for this degree.
- o Must have achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average (G.P.A.) of 2.5 in high school (must provide official high school transcripts demonstrating such G.P.A.) in order to receive initial scholarship award.
- o Must maintain a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 at Burlington County College in order to continue scholarship.
- o Must be a resident of Burlington County.

- o Must indicate a commitment to pursue a career in construction management.
- o Must agree to work at G & C Enterprises, Inc. during the two summers student is enrolled at BCC.
