SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: Mount Holly Advancement

PURPOSE: To provide financial support for qualified Mount Holly residents to attend Burlington County College. This scholarship also contains a mandatory mentoring component through which scholarship recipients will be mentored by business and civic leaders in areas such as work ethic, leadership, attire, and more, in the hope that the recipient(s) will achieve future success in his/her chosen career field.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Local individuals and businesses.

AMOUNT OF AWARD: Varies, but will be at least \$500.

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

All applicants for this scholarship must...

- Be a resident of Mount Holly Township
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Have earned a high school diploma or GED equivalency certificate at the time the scholarship is paid.
- Have achieved a cumulative grade point average of “C” (2.0 on 4.0 scale) or better while in high school.
- Demonstrate academic promise.
- Agree to participate in a guided mentoring program.
- Submit two letters of recommendation, attesting to the applicant’s potential success at Burlington County College and how he/she could benefit from the scholarship.
- Apply for financial aid. The applicant(s) with the greatest unmet financial need will be given priority.

METHOD OF SELECTION: Applications will be reviewed and recommendations made for the award of scholarships by a special selection committee comprised of representatives of the Burlington County College Foundation, BCC Financial Aid Office, and Mount Holly Advancement Scholarship donors.
