AWARD DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: The Pamela Damush-Gaff Award Endowment

ESTABLISHED: This award was established in October of 2001 in honor and memory of the beloved daughter and sister of the Damush family.

PURPOSE: Award based on the recommendation of the BCC Accounting Faculty and awarded at the discretion of the BCC Foundation at the time of graduation to a student matriculating into a BA or BS college program majoring in accounting.

This is a merit based award.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: The Damush Family

AMOUNT OF AWARD: \$500

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Must be a graduating student indicating a commitment to the pursuit of a career in Accounting.
- o Must have successfully completed five courses in Accounting.
- o Must have achieved a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.5.
- o Must provide at least two positive letters of recommendation from professors at BCC.
- o Must submit an essay of 250 - 500 words with scholarship application describing the goals, which the applicant intends to pursue as well as career aspirations in the field of accounting.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

The Accounting faculty at BCC in consultation with the Executive Director of the Foundation.
