SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: Richard M. Harmon Memorial Scholarship

PURPOSE: This scholarship was established to pay tribute to the memory of Richard M. Harmon, who embodied the characteristics of a true gentleman. Mr. Harmon dedicated his life to his family, God and country, and was an ardent advocate of higher education. This endowment fund will provide an annual scholarship to a graduating senior from Holy Cross High School who has demonstrated academic achievement and has a need for financial assistance.

AMOUNT OF AWARD: \$250.00

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Must be a 1992 graduating senior from Holy Cross High School.
- o Must be in a good academic standing if a current or former BCC student.
- o Must be enrolled as a full-time student at Burlington County College.
- o Must have achieved a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. ("B" average).
- o Must submit transcripts of high school record.
- o Must submit three letters of recommendation from three separate sources, including high school teacher, counselor or community person, and a personal reference.
- o Must complete a Burlington County College Foundation Application.
- o Must submit an essay "Why I Should Receive the Richard M. Harmon Scholarship".
- o Must demonstrate active involvement in at least one extracurricular community or volunteer activity.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

BCC Scholarship Selection Committee with final approval of recipient by a member of the Harmon family who will attend the portion of each Scholarship Selection Committee Meeting at which applications for this scholarship are considered.

METHOD OF PAYMENT OF AWARD:

The scholarship will be made in the form of a tuition/fee waiver. No cash award will be made to the recipient.
