SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP NAME: Thomson Lamination Company/Sterling A. Martin Endowed Scholarship

DATE INITIALLY ESTABLISHED: June 15, 1995

PURPOSE: This scholarship has been established by the Thomson Lamination Company and the Sterling A. Martin family to perpetuate the memory of Mr. Thompson and to exemplify the true spirit of community service embodied in the Martin family.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Thomson Lamination Company/Sterling A. Martin Family

AMOUNT AND BASIS OF FUNDING: Scholarships will be offered based upon the earnings of the endowment so long as there exist sufficient earnings to fund one or more full scholarships based upon the earnings alone.

AMOUNT OF AWARD: Full tuition/fees and required books.

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Initial preference in offering scholarships will be made to members of the Martin family and children of employees of the Thomson Lamination Company who have completed a minimum of five (5) years of regular service to the company and who meet such other eligibility criteria as may be established by TLC. If applicants are not available from either of these two groups, the scholarship may, at the discretion of TLC and the Martin family, be offered to other individuals.
- o When selecting scholarship recipients, preference will first be given to those enrolled in engineering programs, next to those enrolled in technology programs, and then to individuals enrolled in other programs.
- o Must be enrolled as a full-time student at Burlington County College in an educational program consistent with that described in the Purpose section.
- o Must have achieved a cumulative grade point average (G.P.A.) of 3.0 in high school and any college courses previously taken at any institution (must provide official transcripts demonstrating such G.P.A. in order to receive initial scholarship award).
- o Must maintain a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 at Burlington County College in order to continue scholarship.
- o Must submit an essay of 250 - 500 words with scholarship application describing academic goals which she/he intends to pursue while enrolled at Burlington County College as well as career aspirations.

METHOD OF SELECTION: BCC Scholarship Selection Committee. One or more representatives of the Thomson Lamination Company and/or the Martin family may choose to be involved in the selection process to the extent that such individuals deem appropriate at any given point in time.
