SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: The Williams Companies Scholarship

DATE INITIALLY ESTABLISHED: January 7, 2008

PURPOSE: This scholarship is designed to assist students who plan to enroll full time at Burlington County College in the academic year immediately following their high school graduation. The scholarship has been designed for female, African-American or Latino or Native American students in the following academic majors: Electronics Engineering Technology, Automotive Technology, Chemical Engineering, or Engineering.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: The Williams Companies

AMOUNT OF AWARD: Tuition and fees, not to exceed \$1,500.00.

NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Must have a high school diploma or G.E.D.
- o Must have graduated high school with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- o Must submit copies of any and all high school transcripts.
- o Must maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 to maintain the scholarship for a second semester.
- o Must be enrolled as a full-time (minimum of twelve credits per semester) student.
- o Internships may be available to the recipient provided the recipient maintains a GPA of at least 3.0 while enrolled at Burlington County College.
- o Must submit an essay 250-500 words with scholarship application describing the goals which the applicant intends to pursue while enrolled at Burlington County College as well as career aspirations in the field the applicant is pursuing or intends to pursue.
- o Must submit a completed Burlington County College Foundation Scholarship application.

The scholarship will be made in the form of a tuition/fee waiver. No cash award will be made to the recipient.
