### **SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION**

**SCHOLARSHIP TITLE:** The Greater Bordentown Business & Professional Women's Club In Memory of Winnie B. Brady

**PURPOSE:** This scholarship is designed to assist a woman returning to the pursuit of her education following a hiatus of several years (must have been out of high-school for a minimum of five years) who plans to enter or re-enter the workforce, make a career change, or advance within her current career field.

**SOURCE OF FUNDING:** The Greater Bordentown Business & Professional Women's Club

**AMOUNT AND BASIS OF FUNDING:** Greater Bordentown Business & Professional Women's Club Scholarship Endowment

**AMOUNT OF AWARD:** \$1,000 per year (\$500 for the Fall semester and \$500 for the Spring semester). Both full-time and part-time students are eligible. Amount of scholarship will not exceed the actual costs of tuition and fees. Costs of books are also eligible for reimbursement as indicated in the payment section of this scholarship description.

**NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:** Varies

#### **APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- o Must be a woman.
- o Must be a resident of Burlington County.
- o Must submit an essay of 500 words describing why applicant believes she should be awarded a scholarship as well as her short and long term educational and career goals.
- o Must maintain a minimum G.P.A. of 2.0 or has satisfactorily completed basic skills courses at Burlington County College in order to be eligible to reapply for subsequent scholarships.
- o The names and home addresses of selected recipients will be submitted to the Greater Bordentown Business & Professional Women's Club so that they may be invited to a dinner meeting of the organization.

#### **METHOD OF SELECTION:**

BCC Scholarship Selection Committee. At the discretion of the Club, a member of the Greater Bordentown Business & Professional Women's Club may attend the portion of each Scholarship Selection Committee Meeting at which applications for this scholarship are considered.
