SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: Mortimer J. Harrison Broadcasting Scholarship

PURPOSE: To provide students with the opportunity to work in the broadcasting field while they pursue an education.

NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIP(S): Varies

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Must be a resident of Burlington County.
- o Must have been a volunteer at WBZC-FM for at least one semester.
- o Must serve a minimum of ten hours a week in a non-paid position at WBZC-FM for each semester selected as scholarship recipient.
- o Must be enrolled as a full-time (minimum of twelve credits per semester) student or part-time student (minimum of six credits per semester) at Burlington County College.
- o Must be currently enrolled as a Communication Arts, Entertainment Technology, or Journalism Major, or in a closely related major as determined by the BCC Foundation staff.
- o Must have demonstrated academic ability as evidenced by a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher for College courses taken.

METHOD OF SELECTION: BCC Scholarship Selection Committee, approval of recommended candidates by the Mortimer J. Harrison Scholarship Committee and final approval by the management of WBZC-FM.
