SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: Mt. Holly/Vincentown Kiwanis Scholarship

PURPOSE: To provide an annual scholarship for students in the Mt. Holly/Vincentown area (Mt. Holly, Eastampton, Southampton, Westampton, Lumberton, and Hainesport) who demonstrate academic ability and who have a need for some financial assistance in order to successfully complete a course of study at Burlington County College.

All active Burlington County College Circle K Club Members, regardless of town residence, are particularly encouraged to apply.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Mt. Holly/Vincentown Kiwanis Club

AMOUNT OF AWARD: Varies

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Must have a high school diploma or G.E.D.
- o Must submit copies of any and all high school and/or College transcripts.
- o Must be in good academic standing if a current or former BCC student.
- o Must be a resident of Mt. Holly, Vincentown, Eastampton, Southampton, Westampton, Lumberton, or Hainesport. This restriction does not apply to Burlington County College active Circle K Club Members.
- o Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the Burlington County College Scholarship Committee. In determining financial need, the College will use its discretion in judging the financial need of an individual based upon the needs of each individual in the pool of applicants for the scholarship at the time selection is made. In any case, the recipient does not have to meet federal or state financial aid guidelines in order to qualify for this scholarship. If two or more applicants have equal qualifications, the applicant with the greater financial need will be given priority.
- o Must submit an essay with scholarship application describing academic goals which the applicant intends to pursue while enrolled at Burlington County College as well as career aspirations in the field the applicant is pursuing or intends to pursue.
- o Must have achieved a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) of 3.0.
- o Must be a second year student at Burlington County College (29 credits completed).
- o Must provide at least two positive letters of recommendation from high school teachers and/or counselors who actually taught or counseled the applicant. If an individual has been out of high school for more than four years, letters from employers and/or officers of community organizations in which the applicant is serving or served may be submitted in lieu of letters from teachers or counselors.
- o Must submit a completed Burlington County College Foundation Scholarship Application.

The scholarship will be made in the form of a tuition/fee waiver. No cash award will be made to the recipient.
