SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

SCHOLARSHIP TITLE: Bruns John and Antonina Widzenas Agricultural Scholarship

PURPOSE: The Widzenas Scholarship is presented annually to a Burlington County born student who plans to pursue a career in agriculture or a closely related field.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Widzenas Family

AMOUNT AND BASIS OF FUNDING: The endowment fund will fund one scholarship for full-time tuition and fees providing that the principle in the endowment fund does not fall below \$10,000.

AMOUNT OF AWARD: Full-time tuition and fees.

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- o Must be enrolled as a full-time (minimum of twelve credits per semester) student with an agriculturally intended career in mind.
- o The recipient must read the book, Sudiev prior to receiving the scholarship.
- o Must be born and raised in Burlington County.

METHOD OF SELECTION: Burlington County College Foundation Scholarship Committee

METHOD OF PAYMENT: The scholarship will be made in the form of a tuition/fee waiver. No cash award will be made to the recipient.

OTHER: In the event there are two or more equally deserving students, each student will write a book report on Sudiev. The winner will be determined by the college English faculty.
