Burlington County residents make up 94.0% of the total student population.

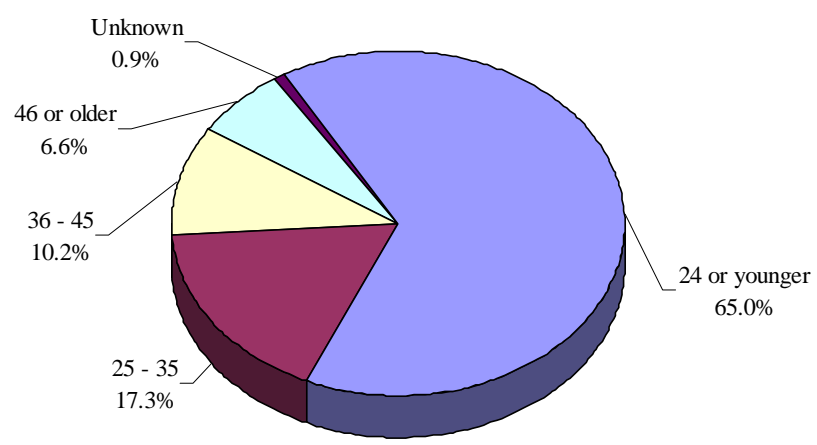
