I was informed by Mr. Gonzalez Director of Public Safety of a possible medical problem that may have begun in a microbiology class to a student who was now ill and who was going to be taken to the hospital to be checked. He showed me an email from the parent of a student, to Ralph Fleming an adjunct instructor, asking what his daughter was handling during class yesterday that could make her sick and if so how serious would it be. He made his cell phone number available indicating he was thinking of taking her to the emergency room for treatment. Mr. Gonzalez asked if I would go to the Mt. Laurel campus and meet with Mrs. Barbara Stewart, Lab Safety Coordinator and Mr. Ralph Fleming the instructor to discuss the safety protocol of the class and of the lab so we would have information to forward to the parents concerning the questions and concerns mentioned in the email. While I was in his office he called Barbara Stewart and advised her I would be responding to her location and why. I also intercepted a call to Mr. Gonzalez from Dr. David Spang Dean of the SMT Department and advised him I would have Mr. Gonzalez return his call. I then left the Pemberton Campus at approximately 1300hrs., for the Mt. Laurel Campus and arrived there at approximately 1325hrs. and proceeded to the microbiology lab with Barbara Stewart to meet with Mr. Fleming who was between classes. Both advised me of the safety training given to the new students before they even begin any experiments and how they are instructed to follow those safety protocols before entering class, during class, and when in the process of leaving class. Barbara Stewart showed me the form the student in question specifically and all students are required to read and sign indicating their understanding of the safety protocol. Mr. Fleming advised he spends most of the first class with the safety protocol for the class and for the experiments that will be done during the semester. The latter is also repeated before these experiments are begun to ensure everybody understands what they are required to do. I stood by and watched a class enter the lab and observed they did exactly what Barbara and Ralph told me they were suppose to do. The students place their books and bags in the space provided, put on their lab coats and go to their the sink and wash their hands. After this they put on gloves and clean their table tops with a solution and paper towel and then are ready to begin class. When they are finished they take their experiments and equipment to the rear of the lab and dispose of each item in its specific place ending by taking off their gloves. They then clean their table tops again following the same procedure as when they first arrived for class ending by washing their hands removing their lab coats and exiting the lab. I was informed by both Mr. Fleming and Mrs. Stewart that when they arrive to do anything in the labs they also follow the same process of cleaning the table tops and also when they leave. The medium that is used for the experiments is not an infectious product as is the actual biological bug. In order to even maybe get slightly ill from the material used in class, and this is a reach, the student would have to intentionally take all the experiments used in class, which are destroyed at the end of each class, and ingest them. None of the experiments are air born in nature so the only conceivable contamination would be through ingestion and as I previously stated the quantity would have to be enormous.

~~While I was at the Mt. Laurel site Barbara received a call from Dr. Spang who advised her the parent and~~

student were at the hospital and the parent advised he would keep the college informed. As I mentioned Mrs. Stewart and Mr. Fleming will be forwarding their written statements and also documentation concerning how the students are given safety information what safety information is given and their protocol concerning disposition of the experiments etc. This concludes my report at this time pending further information.
